## Speakers



**Jakov Bibulovic** is the Evangelism, Church Growth and Church Planting director for the Ontario Conference. After immigrated to Canada 1997, Jakov graduated with Masters in Contextual Theology from University of Toronto and pastored Toronto Yugoslavian and Barrie Churches. He is passionate about soul winning, church planting and “discipleship evangelism.”



**Daniel & Alisha Christie** Daniel is a church planter in the NNSW Conference, Australia. After graduating from an Australian evangelism school in 2006, Daniel went on to do evangelism and pastoral work for four years before deciding to complete tertiary study. His background in bible work and evangelism, as well as involvement in several church plants during his years as a Theology student led to his call to plant a new church in the Tweed area of NNSW. The church, named The Vine launched in January 2015 and currently has an average of 40-50 attendees every week, with at least a dozen of those being seekers. Daniel and his wife Alisha share a passion for ministry, as well as a love for healthy living, the outdoors and exercise.



**Tom L. Evans** is an Associate Director for the North American Division Evangelism Institute located at Andrews University. His areas of expertise include: church planting, coaching, and Natural Church Development. During his leadership as church planting director in Texas, 114 new churches were planted over a period of 9 years. Tom is married to Mara (originally from Brazil).
